Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome back! We are heading into the Summer Term!

Our theme this term is Mayans for Summer 1 and Africa for Summer 2. We will be looking at Charlie and the Chocolate Factory as our core text in Summer 1. Our theme will cover English, History, Music, PSHE, and Design and Technology and will link to the texts chosen to explore our theme of the Mayans for this half term.
