Homework tasks should be submitted as they are finished and will be marked and returned promptly. **Spelling tests** will be completed on **Fridays**. The spelling list is on the school website.

**PE** is on **Tuesday morning (Outdoor) and Thursday afternoon (indoor)**. Please ensure your child has appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons and all items are labelled. Earrings should not be worn on these days and **no other jewellery should be worn** to school.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom. Your child will have opportunities to choose a variety of reading books throughout the term. These books should be brought home and the reading record should be completed when your child reads. Please encourage your child to read daily at home and record it in their reading records. Reading records and books cost a lot of money to replace, therefore we will continue to charge for any lost reading records or books accordingly.
