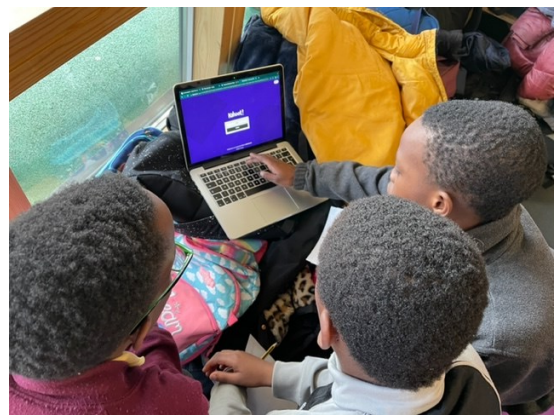
Paper aeroplane statistics
