Homework is set each week in the CGP books in Maths, Grammar and Comprehension. Please ensure that your child is completing the pages that have been set for that week. Reading is a really important part of your child's learning. Children should read every evening for at least 20 minutes. We suggest that you listen to your child read at least three times a week, each time signing their reading record – this will significantly improve their reading and writing skills. Reading records and books cost a lot of money to replace, therefore we will continue to charge for any lost reading records or books accordingly.

Spelling tests will be completed on Thursdays in Einstein class and Fridays in Walker class.

PE is on **Monday afternoon** (outdoor) and **Friday afternoon** (indoor). Please ensure your child has appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons and all items are labelled. Earrings should not be worn on these days and no other jewellery should be worn to school.
