Dear Year 5 Parents/Carers,

We hope you have had a blessed and restful break. Here is an overview of the following spring term.

### The curriculum

In English and Geography, work will be based around the Extreme Environments. Our main text will be 'Ice trap- Shackleton's Expedition' by Meredith Hooper and 'Race to the North- The Matthew Henson story' by Catherine Johnson. In Maths, we will be focusing on multiplication, division, percentages and fractions.

Our topic in science is Materials and their properties, this will involve learning about different materials and their properties, comparing and exploring them in everyday items. Additionally, we will be looking at the reversible changes in solids, liquid and gases. Children will take part in asking questions, making careful observations about the world around them and recording key information. Finally, in Religious Education we are learning about the religious teachings of Judaism.

# Homework, daily reading and spelling

The homework menu and spelling has been handed out and uploaded on Satchel. We encourage all children to complete their homework where they can online. Tasks such as handwriting can be done in their homework book. Children are expected to complete at least 4 pieces across this half term. However, if you wish to complete more than 4, we will be happy to receive them. Spellings will be tested every Friday afternoon.

Please try and read with your child <u>each evening</u> and talk to them about the book they are reading. You can then sign their reading record each time, asking them questions about what they are reading will help develop their comprehension.
