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## **Useful Information and Expectations**

#### The start and end of the school Day

Gates open for drop off between **8.40 am and 8.55 am** for all pupils. Please try not to arrive too early as we cannot open the gate until 8.40am. Pupils should be collected promptly at the end of the day at **3.10 pm**. Please ensure your child's pick-up arrangements are communicated with the school. Reception pupils are dismissed from the classroom and all other years are dismissed from the playground in near the main gate.

#### Attendance and Punctuality

We would like to encourage 100% attendance and welcome your support with this. Children who are not in school by **8.55 am**, miss out on the essential information that class teachers give their children, as well as the settling down time each morning, in preparation for a day of high quality, interesting and fun learning. It is important that we know where the children are and we are required by law to record this information; please call the school office, or answer your phone to school so that we can ensure all children are safe and well.

#### School Lunch

School dinners are **FREE** to all children in school. Please take up this opportunity. Dinners are prepared and cooked fresh each day in our own kitchen. If your child brings a packed lunch to school, please ensure it is healthy and **does not include nuts**, sweets, chocolate or fizzy drinks. All packed lunch bags should be well labelled.

#### <u>Snacks</u>

Children in year groups Reception, 1 and 2 are provided with a piece of fruit each day. Pupils in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 are permitted to bring in fruit for a snack at break time – no other food is allowed, **especially nuts** as we are a **NO NUT school**.

#### **Allergies**

We have multiple children and staff members with nut allergies, some of which are <u>airborne and are</u> <u>extremely dangerous</u>. You will have received information from the admin teams, but we will continue to remind you about this allergy to ensure that all members of our school community are safe.

#### Please do not send your child into school with;

- Any nuts
- Nutella or other chocolate spread containing nuts
- Peanut butter
- Snacks/ cereal bars containing nuts

Always check the ingredients of any food you are sending into school – , trips, international events, class party food, gifts for staff, packed lunches or anything else, to be certain that they do **NOT** contain nuts. Sometimes it is not obvious!

**PLEASE ENSURE ALL CLOTHES ARE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME.** Lost property will be given to charity at the end of each term! Please ensure that your child is wearing the correct uniform. Shoes and trainers should be black.

### Pencil Cases and Other Items From Home

Children should not bring in pencil cases, pencils, pens or other items from home; only school equipment can be used. This is to ensure fairness to all children.

#### Water Bottles

Please ensure that your child brings a water bottle to school each day – no glass. It needs to be clearly labelled with your child's name and filled with **water** only..

#### **Breakfast Club**

If your child requires a place at our breakfast club. Please telephone the office/Miss Parsons and speak to them about reserving a place. Places need to be paid for in advance.

#### After School Club

Please do not take photos of other children in school. Photos of your child taking part in collective worships, singining etc, should not be put on social media.
