Dear Parents/Carers,

I would like to welcome you all back from the summer break. I hope you all enjoyed the holidays and are well rested. I am looking forward to working with you this year.

This term we will be exploring and comparing **Ancient Civilizations**.

Our theme for this half term is **Tomb Raiders – Ancient Egypt.** Our core text is 'Who built the pyramids?' by Meredith Hooper. We will also be studying: Howard Carter's Discovery of Tutankhamun and Anthony and Cleopatra.

In the second half term our topic will be **Ancient Rome** and we will be reading 'The tale of Romulus and Remus' and we will be covering the following subjects:

We will also have weekly computing, music and PHSE lessons. Our PE days will be **Tuesday and Wednesday**. Therefore, it is imperative that the children have the correct PE kit on these days. It is advisable that your child brings a clean PE kit into school on Monday and takes it home for washing on Friday. PE kits must include a white t-shirt, dark coloured shorts or dark coloured jogging bottoms, a jumper, a fleece and a pair of plimsolls or trainers. Also, it is very important that all of the PE kit is <u>clearly named</u> including the bag it is in.

<u>Swimming</u>

From next week year 4 will be taking part in **weekly swimming lessons** at the Greenwich Centre. These sessions will be **every Wednesday starting on the Wednesday 14th September.** The last swimming session this term will be on the Wednesday 14th December.
