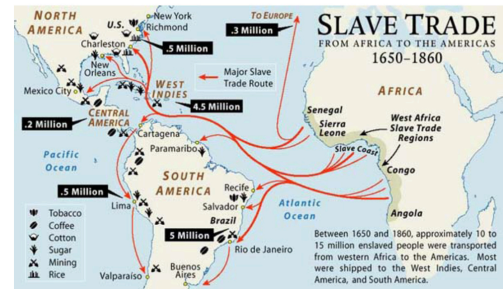
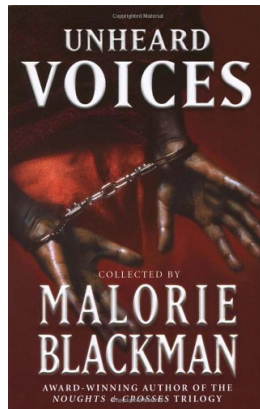


Autumn Term 1

This half term Year 6 will be investigating and exploring the hidden history of Unheard Voices.



As readers, we will be exploring extracts from Unheard Voices by Malorie Blackman and the stories of black people in history.

As writers, we will be authors of biographies of important black figures in history, recording information about slavery and becoming poets, creating our own poems based on Harriet Tubman's songs of the Underground railroad.

As mathematicians, we will explore place value, looking at addition and subtraction and fractions and percentages.

As scientists, we will get close up and personal to our own family of bees and the different plants in our community garden as we explore living things.

As artists and designers, we will be designing and creating a class quilt depicting stories, in the style of Faith Ringgold's work.

As Geographers, we will be looking at the transportation of slaves across the Atlantic Ocean.

As musicians, we will be rewriting Harriet Tubman's songs, giving directions to slaves to help them escape.

As theologians, we will be exploring Sikhism, with a focus on the 5Ks, Sikh festivals and looking at honesty and commitment in different groups.
