Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back. We are heading into the Summer Term. Our theme this term is **Mayans for Summer 1** and **Africa for Summer 2**. We will be looking at Charlie and the Chocolate Factory as our core text in Summer 1. Please make sure your child's clothes are all labelled. The children are responsible for all their own clothes, this includes their school uniform and jumpers/coats etc. Year 3 PE days are Tuesdays and Fridays each week.

Homework expectations can be found on the school website under Year 3 and children should regularly use Spelling Shed and Timetable Rockstar. Spelling tests will be carried out on Friday. Spellings have been given out at the beginning of the Year. If misplaced they can be found on the school website under 'Year 3'.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom and books are changed once children have completed their books. We ask that you support your child's progress by reading regularly with them and completing the reading record when they have read to you. The book will only be changed when you have done. Thank you with your cooperation with this.

As the weather is getting warmer, we kindly ask that all children have a clearly labelled water bottle and appropriate clothes for the weather. If you wish to contact us regarding your child's education, please make an appointment via the office or speak to us after school.
