**Spelling tests** will be completed on a **Friday morning**. Spellings can be found on the school website. Also, children will be given a spelling sheet at the beginning of each half term which contains all of the spellings for the half term and for each week.

Children will need to bring their **PE kits on Monday and Wednesday**. Please ensure your child has appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons. PE kits must include a white t-shirt, shorts and jogging bottoms, a jumper, a fleece and a pair of black plimsolls or trainers. It is very important that all of their uniform, including PE kit and bags, are clearly labelled with their name. Earrings should not be worn on these days and no other jewellery should be worn to school.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom and books are changed regularly. Your child will have opportunities to choose a variety of reading books throughout the term. These books should be brought home and the reading record should be completed when your child has read the book. Please ensure that there is an acknowledgement that your child has read each night by signing their reading records. Your child should bring their book and reading record into school daily.

Throughout the year, trips will be organised for the children and details will be sent nearer the time. As always, we may need parent volunteers in order for these trips to take place; we will try to give you as much notice as possible.
