It has been wonderful to see all the great learning that happened both in school and at home last week. Have a look at some of the wonderful examples of learning across the school.

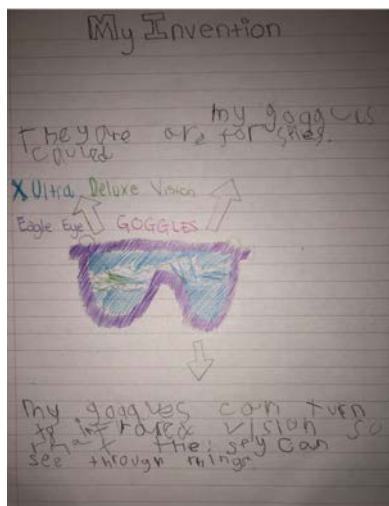
Thank you children for all your hard work and thank you parents and carers for supporting us with our remote learning offer.

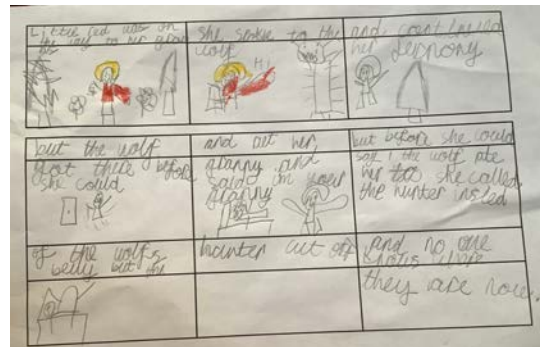
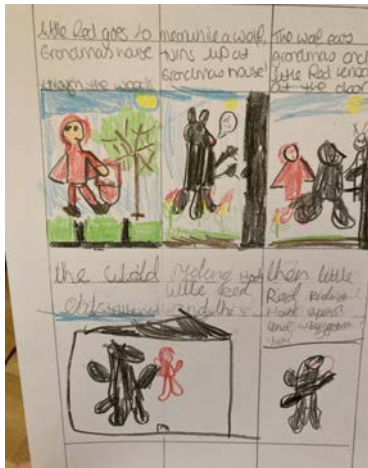
In their RE lesson, the children in reception have been thinking about what makes them unique. They have created some lovely self-portraits and hand print art.



The children in year 1 have been designing some gadgets to help the world.



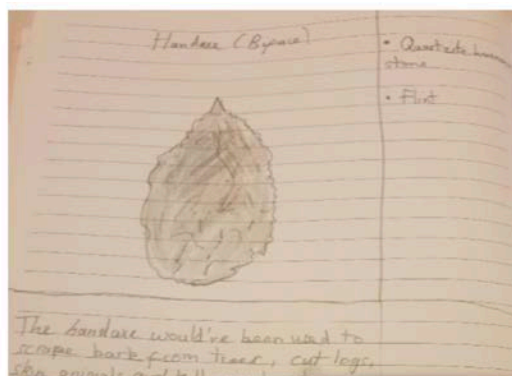
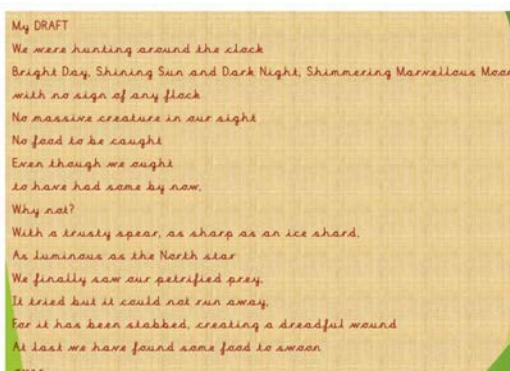
The children in Year 2 have been creating story maps to help them write their own traditional tale.



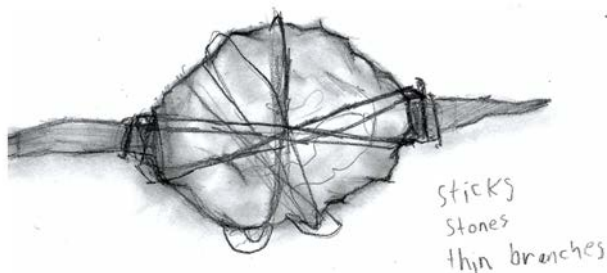
In the year 1 and 2 Bubble the children created Superhero art. They used shapes to create the background and then decorated a superhero to go on our background.



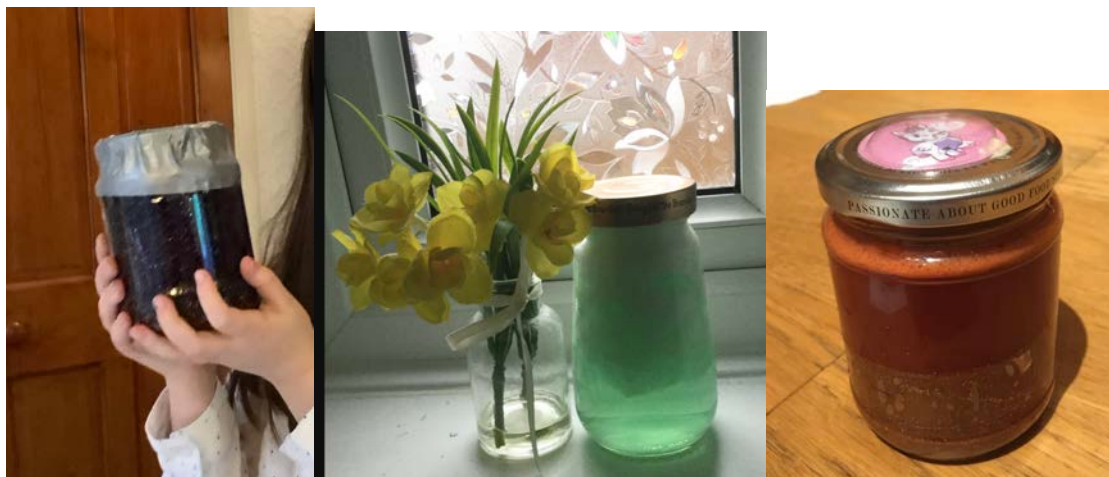

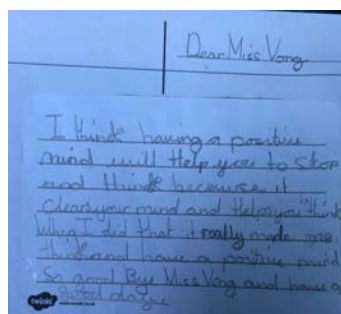
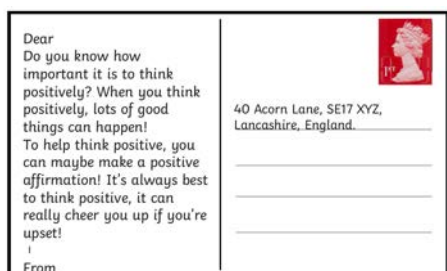
Year 3 Stone Age Art
