Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back after the Easter holiday, we hope you were able to have a good rest.

Our themes during the summer are: 'Marvellous Minibeast' and 'Wherever you will go'.

We will be covering all areas of learning through our topics. In the first half of the term, We will be learning about everything we find in our garden including the different things that grow and the insects that live there. We will also be exploring life cycles and parts of plants. Our focus Text will be A variety of Mini beast fact files. As we head into our final half term in reception, we will be thinking about transport and different journeys we can go on (including moving to year 1!), reading the text Barney goes to the moon. In RE our big questions are 'What makes Jesus special?' and 'Who cares for our special world?'.

PE lessons and physical development focus will take place on **Tuesdays every week**. It is essential that your child brings their full PE kit to school every Tuesday. Your child needs to come to school wearing their full school uniform as they will be getting changed for PE at school. The PE kit needs to contain a white T-shirt, black/dark shorts, jogging bottoms as well as trainers or plimsolls and a tracksuit top. Please ensure all clothes are clearly labelled including the shoes. Please also note that for your own child's welfare, hooped earrings are not to be worn. Only studs are allowed as stated in the school prospectus.

A teacher will change the children's reading books once a week, every Wednesday. Each week, your child will also bring home a pleasure book for you to share together. they will also receive a phonics book that matches their reading level in school. If a reading record is lost, there will be a replacement cost of £1. Lost or damaged school reading books will incur a replacement cost of £6. Each time you read with your child, please make sure you sign their reading record – **If you do not sign your child's reading record we will assume that you have not read the book.**

If you have any queries or concerns, please come and speak to us after school. Alternatively, you can contact us through tapestry or make an appointment at the office, if you wish to have a longer or more private discussion.

I look forward to your support while continuing to work with your child and helping them get the most from their final term in EYFSI.
