**Spelling tests** will be completed on a **Friday morning**. Spellings can be found on the school website. Also, children will be given a spelling sheet at the beginning of each half term which contains all of the spellings for the half term and for each week.

Children will need to bring their **Swimming Kits on Monday**. Please ensure your child has appropriate kit for swimming and all items are labelled. Earrings should not be worn on these days and no other jewellery should be worn to school. If your child arrives late to school on a swimming day, unfortunately they will be unable to take part in the swimming session and will remain in school instead. For safeguarding reasons, children must not go directly to the swimming pool if they arrive late, as this does not align with our supervision arrangements.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom and books are changed regularly. Your child will have opportunities to choose a variety of reading books throughout the term. These books should be brought home and the reading record should be completed when your child reads. Please ensure that there is an acknowledgement that they have read each night by signing their reading records. Your child should bring their book and reading record into school daily.

Throughout the year, trips will be organised for the children and details will be sent nearer the time. As always, we may need parent volunteers in order for these trips to take place; we will try to give you as much notice as possible. If you wish to contact us regarding your child's education please make an appointment via the office. We are usually available before 8.30 a.m. or after school.
