Spelling tests will be completed on a **Friday morning**. Spellings can be found on the school website. Also, children will be given a spelling sheet at the beginning of each half term which contains all of the spellings for the half term and for each week.

Children will need to bring their **PE on Monday and Wednesday**.

Please ensure your child has appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons and all items are labelled. Earrings should not be worn on these days and no other Jewellery should be worn to school.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom and books are changed regularly. Your child will have opportunities to choose a variety of reading books throughout the term. These books should be brought home and the reading record should be completed when your child reads.
