Dear Parents/ Carers,

Welcome to the new term.

Throughout the year, we will be using themes to teach our skills-based curriculum. Our running themes for the Spring term are **How can I change my world?** and **Space Explorers**. Our themes will cover English, Geography, History, Music, PSHE, ICT, Art and DT and link to texts chosen to explore our themes for the term.

Spring 1

Science: Forest school (animals)	Maths: Place value to 20, addition and subtraction
Religious Education: Judaism	English: Talk for writing – Clean Up (Poetry and letter writing)
PSHE: Zones of Regulations and Belonging to a community	DT: Structures - Making desk tidies

Spring 2

Science: Forest school (animals)	Maths: Place value to 50, length and height
Religious Education: Christianity - Easter	English: Man on the Moon – Non-chronological report
PSHE: Zone of regulations, Media literacy and Digital Resilience	Art: Colour

Children will come to school bringing their PE kits every **Thursday** (indoor PE) and on **Friday** (outdoor PE). They will continue to attend Forest School every **Tuesday**. Please ensure your child has an appropriate kit for outdoor lessons, especially when the weather continues to be colder. Black or blue shorts and white t-shirts should always be worn for indoor PE. **Please make sure your child's clothes are all labelled. The children are responsible for their clothing.**

Parents are encouraged to take children on some of our suggested Cultural Capital trips to broaden their learning experiences. We are in the process of finalising details of our upcoming trip to the farm and we should be in touch shortly with more information. **Spelling tests will be starting back every Friday** and the list of weekly spellings will be sent out a week in advance.

Reading books are changed on Fridays. We ask that you support your child's progress by reading regularly with them and completing the reading record when they have read to you. The book will only be changed when you have done so. Please remember to write a short comment in the reading record regarding your child's progress and sign it.
