Continuus Provision that we have implemented this academic year has made a very positive impact on children's academic progress and on their wellbeing. Our carefully planned learning environment enables our children to access resources and manipulatives independently so they can consolidate their skills, knowledge and understanding. This approach to learning helps them to be resilient learners who motivate themselves to take on the next challenge.

Children will come to school bringing their P.E. kits every **Tuesday** (indoor PE) and on **Thursday** (outdoor PE).
