Spelling tests will be completed on a **Friday morning**. Spellings can be found on the school website. Also, children will be given a spelling sheet at the beginning of each half term which contains all of the spellings for each week of the half term.

Children will need to bring their **PE kits on Monday and Wednesday**. Please ensure your child has appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons and all items are labelled. Earrings should not be worn on these days and no other jewelry should be worn to school.
