Dear Parent /Carers,

As we come to an end of an extraordinary term, we would like to share some key information which will enable you to plan for the next academic year.

Since our last correspondence, we have continued the wider opening of the primary campuses. We have welcomed Years 2 -5 in for 4 days into bubbles of 15 pupils. Throughout the period of lockdown through to the end of this Summer term we have had over 400 pupils attend school across our campuses.

#### **Home Learning**

Thank you to all of our families who have continued with home learning. We appreciate that this has been a very difficult time for families and balancing your own work, alongside teaching your children can be quite stressful. Our home learning provision will cease on Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July. Please encourage your child to do as much learning as possible in the few days that we have left of this term. If you would like your child to continue some form of learning over the summer break you are still able to access the Oak National Academy resources which are available for all year groups.

#### **End of Term**

The last day of the school year will be Friday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2020. School will be closing at the normal closing time for Fridays. Please collect your child at the correct time.

## **September INSET Days**

As we shared in our letter last week, our INSET days next term will be Wednesday  $2^{nd}$ , Thursday  $3^{rd}$  and Friday  $4^{th}$  September. Teachers and school staff will use these days to prepare their classrooms and ensure the school is ready for students to return on Monday  $7^{th}$  September 2020.

# New Reception and Year 7 starter

#### Year 6

### **Uniform**

Our school uniform supplier, Khalsa Schoolwear, now has a uniform shop in Crayford, as well as Bethnal Green. You are now able to order primary and secondary uniform directly from Khalsa Schoolwear from their shops or from their website.

**Primary uniform** – From September we are changing the logos on our school uniform items to match our logos that have been used on all other school branding for several years. We still hold some stock with our old logo which the primary admin offices are able to sell to you before the end of term. Please telephone the school office if you are interested in purchasing these at a slightly discounted rate.

#### **Dinner Money**

Please ensure you have settled any outstanding money for your child's dinners before the end of term. If your child is in Year 6 or is leaving the Koinonia Federation at the end of the school term and you think you are in credit for school meals, please contact the school office to arrange a refund. Credit for other year groups will be carried over to the Autumn term.

Unfortunately, we have been informed that our school meal provider GS Plus have had to increase the cost of school meals. This means a cost of a paid pupil school meal will be £2.75 from September. We understand that this change in price comes at a difficult time for many families, but as you will be aware school budgets are decreasing each year and we are unable to subside this extra cost.

## Free School Meal Vouchers

As you may have heard on the news, if you are entitled to free school meals under the benefit criteria (not the universal infant criteria) you will continue to receive free school meal vouchers during the Summer break. Free school meals vouchers will be generated automatically and you will receive them via email.
