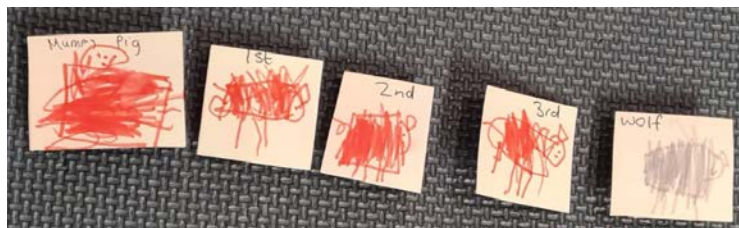

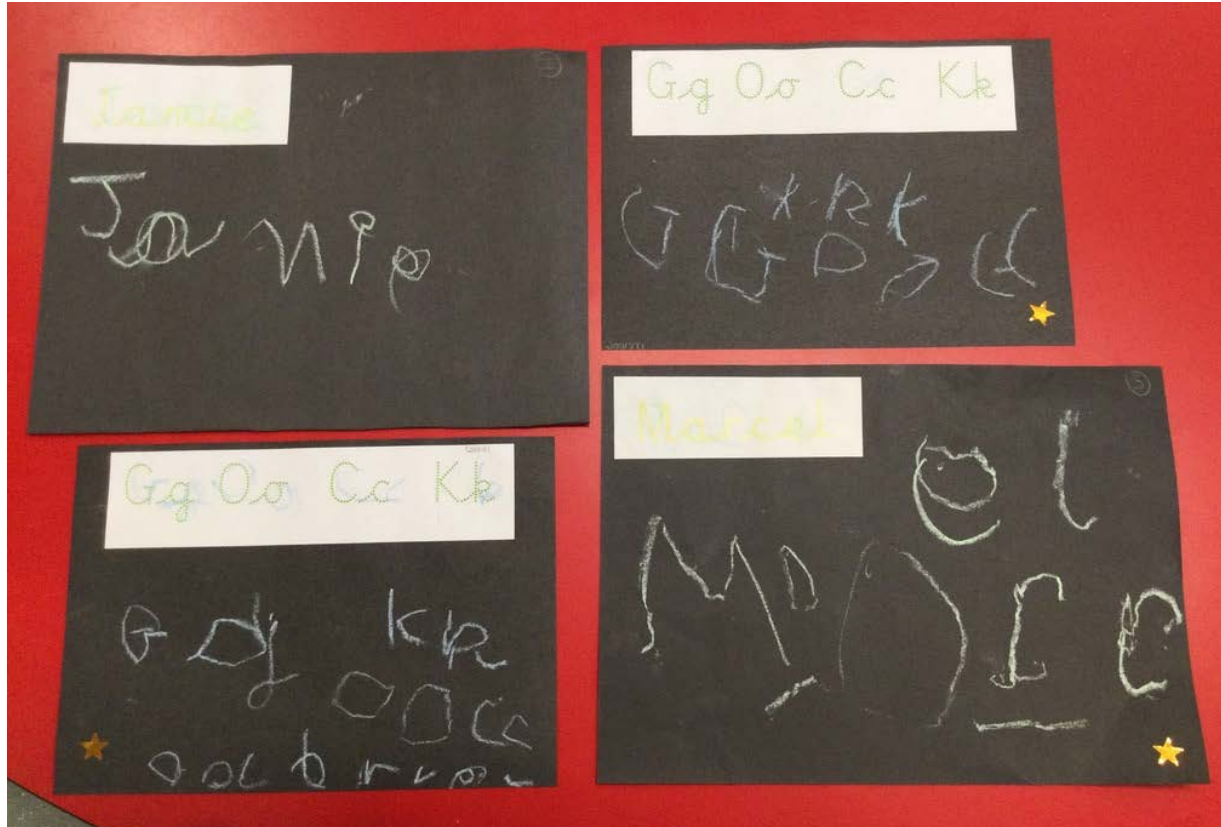

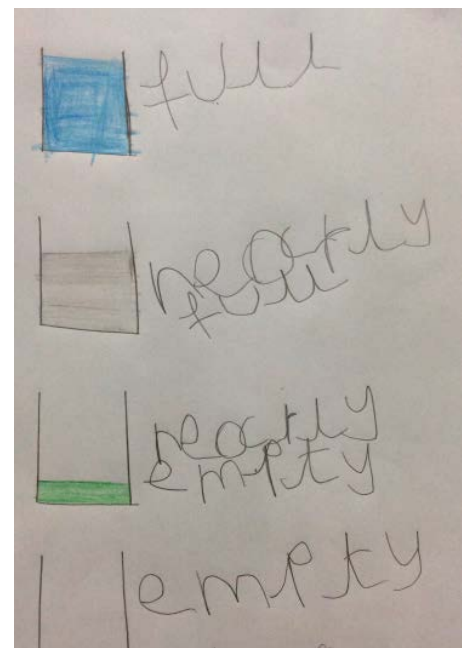




This week **Reception pupils – Orchard and Bellamy** classes, have been writing their names and phonics sounds using chalk.

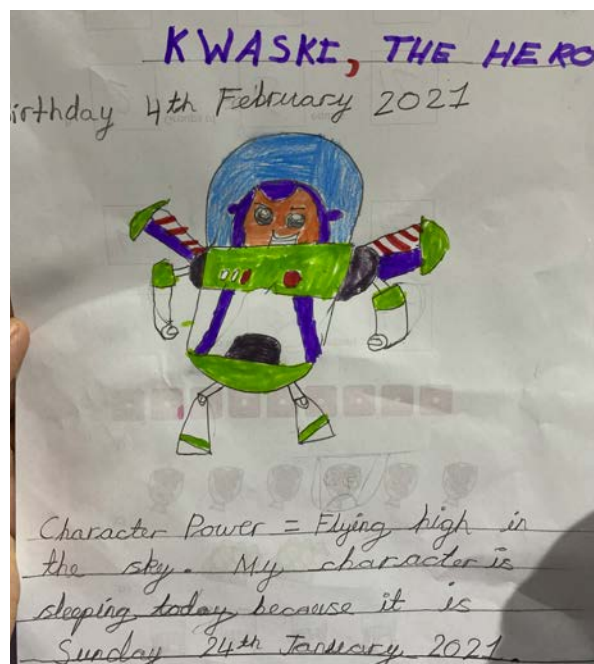

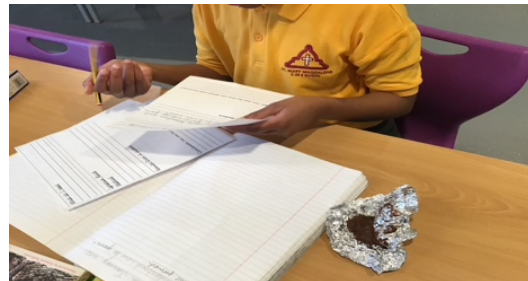
