It has been great to see and hear about some of the learning that you have been doing at home. All the adults in school are really proud of the work that has been submitted – well done!!

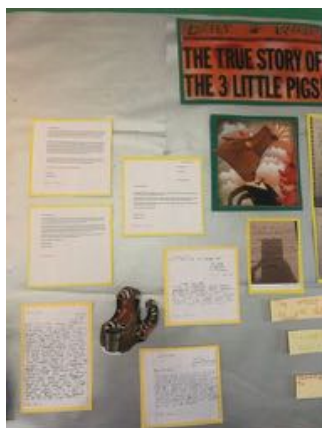
Do have a look at some of the amazing learning that has been happening at home and in school over the last couple of weeks.

The children in the Year 1 and 2 bubble have been making gingerbread houses. They have also been drawing life size images of themselves.



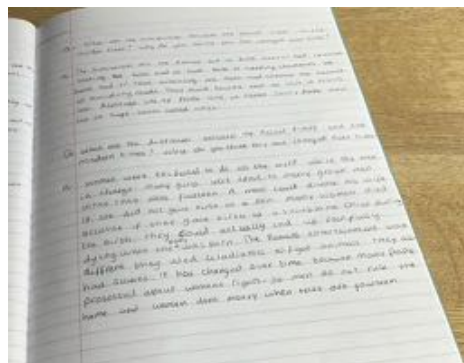
Year 3 have been learning some poetry. They have been memorising poems using picture story maps to help them.
