Dear Parents/ Carers of Year 1,

Following our previous correspondence regarding the reopening of schools we would like to share with you the specific details for the return of your child to school. Please read this information alongside the letter we issued on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> May as well as our Questions and Answer sheet which is also attached.

After successfully welcoming back our year 6 pupils at Christ Church and St Mary Magdalene Woolwich this week we are pleased to confirm that we will open on **Tuesday 9**<sup>th</sup> **June** for **Year 1**. We have reviewed our practices and have put into place what has been learnt with this cohort of pupils ready for the next phase of reopening.

It is extremely important to remember that no child displaying symptoms of the virus (or who is living with a member of the household who is displaying symptoms) should be sent to school.

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WHAT TO BRING TO SCHOOL	Children should <b>not</b> bring anything to school except for a water bottle and a hat. They will also need to bring a packed lunch if they are not having a school dinner. They do <b>not</b> need a school bag.
SCHOOL UNIFORM	Please send your child to school wearing their school uniform or clothes that are as close to this as possible and practical. They need sensible practical shoes as they will not be getting changed for PE. If you are having trouble finding uniform that still fits your child, please contact our Home School Link Worker who may be able to help. We would recommend washing clothing worn to school every day where possible.

Regular cleaning of rooms and resources will take place throughout the day and after school. The school is closing early on a Friday to ensure that there is an enhanced clean before the next week.

Children will be dismissed from the Charles Grinling Walk gates. They will line up in the Muga pitch with their teachers and will be dismissed one at a time. Please be patient as dismissal will take longer than usual. If you are collecting your child, please wait on the pavement using the social distancing markings on Charles Grinling Walk (no parent/carer should enter the school grounds).
