








HOMework 'TAKE-AWAY' MENU Year 5 Summer Term 1 Theme: It's All Greek To Me.

| <p>ENGLISH Activity 1</p> <p>Research and write a biography of your favourite character from Greek mythology. It can be a god/goddess, hero/heroine or an evil villain/beast (Medusa or the Minotaur).</p> | <p>GEOGRAPHY</p> <p>You are planning a Family Summer holiday to Greece, but you know nothing about it. Create a Brochure to outline information about Greece Include population, weather, how much it costs to go there, where can one stay as a tourist, what to eat, places to visits (landmarks).</p> | <p>SCIENCE Activity 1</p> <p>Create a space word search.
