Clothes labelling

Please label <u>all your child's belongings</u> clearly with their name, including their shoes, school bags, water bottles and COATS.











Getting dressed



It is very useful if your child wears Velcro shoes or slip on pumps.

Velcro fastening shoes and slip on pumps can be less frustrating for both child and teacher in the early stages.

Belts are not appropriate.



Milk and Fruit

Your child will receive fresh fruit and a carton of milk every day which is free of charge.

If your child suffers from any allergies please let the school office know and inform Mrs. Akinwoleola as well please.







Going to the toilet

It can be very worrying if a child cannot manage to go to the toilet without assistance. There are often stiff fasteners, particularly on school trousers or tights which can be tricky. Do reassure your child that they can always go to the toilet when needed.

During class time whether they are inside or out they can access the toilet independently. All children should know how to flush the toilet after use and wash their hands independently.
