SATs

- SATs will be held between 8th – 11th May 2023
 - Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar
 - Reading
 - Maths
 - Arithmetic
 - Reasoning (x2 papers)
- Marked externally (writing will be assessed by your child's teacher and moderated)
- Children are awarded a scale score and raw score
 - Raw score – their exact number of marks
 - Scaled score - where 100 is national average.



Helping From Home

- Maths

- Random recall of times tables
- Real life maths

- Writing

- Daily practice of words
- Opportunities to write

- Reading

- Ask questions and discuss the text being read
- Read with your child (take turns to read)
- Reading a range of genres

- In addition

- Spend time playing games and having conversations
- Praise and encourage the small success
- Targeted screen time
- Rest and relaxation time
