Spelling tests will be completed every **Friday**. Children will be given a new spelling sheet each **Monday** in their home spelling books. Please ensure that these are returned **weekly**. Spare sheets are in the classroom. They have logins for TTRS and Spelling shed (edshed.com) in these books. **TimesTable rockstars** (TTRS) can be accessed online; logins are in spelling books. Please complete 5-10 mins, 4-5 times a week. Prioritise the 3,4,6, 8 and 9-times tables including division facts.

To consolidate and strengthen English and Maths learning, each **Monday** homework will be given in homework folders. Each child must return the folders by **Monday** each week.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom. Reading books should be brought home, and the reading record should be signed once your child reads. Your child should bring their book and reading record into school every **Monday** to be checked and each time a book is completed.

Children need to come into school in their **PE kits on Thursday and Friday**. Please ensure your child has an appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons. The PE kit must have black or navy jogging bottoms, a plain white T-Shirt and black trainers.
