Spelling tests will be completed every **Friday**. Children will be given a new spelling sheet each **Friday** in their home spelling books. Please ensure that these are returned **weekly**. Spare sheets are in the classroom. Logins for **Spelling Shed** (Edshed.com) will be sent out when the term begins and have weekly online assignments to compliment the weekly spellings.

Children will need to come into school in their **PE kits on Tuesday and Thursday**. Please ensure your child has an appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons. The PE kit must have black or navy jogging bottoms, a plain white T-Shirt and black trainers.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom. Reading books should be brought home, and the reading record should be signed once your child reads. Your child should bring their book and reading record into school every **Wednesday** to be checked and each time a book is completed.

To compliment reading, each **Wednesday** comprehension homework will be given following our Spelling Shed scheme. Each child must complete the worksheet and return by the following **Wednesday**.

TimesTable rockstars (TTRS) can be accessed online; logins are in spelling books. Please complete 5-10 mins, 4-5 times a week. Prioritise the 3,4- and 8-times tables including division facts.

This term we have a few trips planned for Year 3. As always, we need parent volunteers in order for these trips to take place; we will try to give you as much notice as possible. If you wish to contact us regarding your child's education, please make an appointment via the office. We are usually available before 8.30 a.m. or after school.
