#### In year 4, we will be looking at Tomb Raiders.

As Writers, we will be writing instructions of mummification process, write a newspaper report of the discovery of Tutankhamun and non-chronotogical report based on Egyptians.

As Mathematicians, we will be reinforcing our knowledge of number and place value. We will also learn to recognise and use Roman Numerals. We shall continue to use all four operations to solve number problems.

As Scientists, we will be investigating the digestive system and the nutrients needed to keep animals including humans alive.

As Designers, we will create a historical artefact based on modern day materials. As Historians, we will be using several artefacts to describe what daily life was like in Ancient Egypt. We will start to learn to translate hierographics.

As Theologists, we will be visiting Islam and learning about how <u>Muslims</u> worship and their customs and traditions.


