Dear Parents/Carers

Welcome to a new term and a New Year! I hope you had a very enjoyable and restful break.

During this term we will be following the creative curriculum based around a core text. The text we will be studying will be 'Ice Trap' (Shackleton's Incredible Expedition) by Meredith Hooper. We will be studying English, Geography, History, Music, DT, PSHE, Computing and Art by linking these subjects to our texts for this term.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom and books are changed regularly so your child must bring their reading records and reading books to school every day.
