
Autumn Term /

As designers, we will be designing and creating a class quilt depicting stories, in the style of Faith Ringgold's work.

As geographers, we will be looking at the transportation of slaves across the Atlantic Ocean.

As theologists, we will be exploring Sikhism, with a focus on the 5Ks, Sikh festivals and looking at honesty and commitment in different groups.
