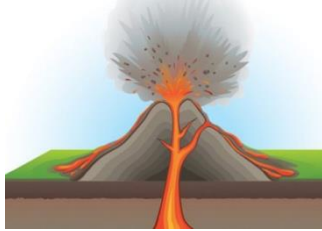

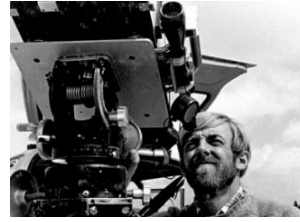
Join Year 4, as we become avid explorers of the wonderful, ancient world of violent volcanoes, mighty mountains & earthquakes.
