Dear Parent/Carer,

School Gateway

Your child will need to either bring money to top up their account in school at the biometric machine or bring a packed lunch. Once fixed, you will hopefully only need to re-activate your account. However, there is a possibility that you may need to make new account. If we need to make contact regarding your child, we will call you.
