Dear Parent/Carers ,

A huge thank you to all of you who decided to send your children to school this week. We have enjoyed a successful and safe return to school for our year 10 students. If you decided to not send your children this week, I hope you continued to encourage them in completing their home learning and will consider sending them to school next week.

After consulting many staff members and speaking to most of our year 10 students, the final decision as to what the year 10 timetable over the next 4 weeks will look like has been made.

Omega 2, Gamma 2, Alpha 2 they will attend school on Wednesday and Thursday
(Omega 2 start at 9am, Gamma 1 at 9.30am and Alpha 1 at 10am)

You will also be receiving a personal text confirming which day your child is to attend school.
