Dear Parent/Carer,

I write to you to firstly wish you all a great summer, to provide a few more details about the week to come and provisional plans for September. As you will know, this Thursday is the last day of term for students as Friday 23rd July is an INSET day. The dismissal times for each year group are as follows:
