Dear Parent/Carers,

Further to my letter sent to you on Friday, I write to you with the final plans for our phased return to school, beginning next week Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. The Local Authority have changed their offer in terms of lateral flow tests, and as such, we have had to amend our plans for testing.

The most important change is that we will test some students this week on Friday 5<sup>th</sup> March. This will enable us to welcome some students back to lessons on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March. The remaining students will be tested on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> March and then return to lessons on Wednesday. <u>Please note, regardless of which year groups return to face to face learning first, all families of key workers will still be able to attend school within our school Hub – much like they are doing at the moment.</u>
