Step 1 – Receiving Your Invitation

On 29 November, parents will receive an email to the primary contact email address we have for your child from <u>noreply@sims.co.uk</u> with the subject St *Mary Magdalene CE All Through School invites you to SIMS Parent*; an example of how this may appear is show below. Step 2 – Setting Up Your Account

As well as A-Levels, we also offer a range of BTECs; please note that some of these (National Extended Certificates) are equivalent to one A-Level; others (National Diplomas) are equivalent to two A-Levels and count as two 'choices'. Please see below for how this might appear if a student selected a BTEC Applied Science National Diploma and a BTEC Performing Arts National Extended Certificate.



Most students will wish to select three A-Levels or BTECs although the highest achieving students may wish to select four A-Levels/BTECs.

Step 5 - Adjusting Orders of Preference



Choices automatically appear in the order they have been selected. However, please ensure they are in the order of preference. To alter the order, you can swap the options around by clicking on the options you wish to move around (see below).
