**THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK....**

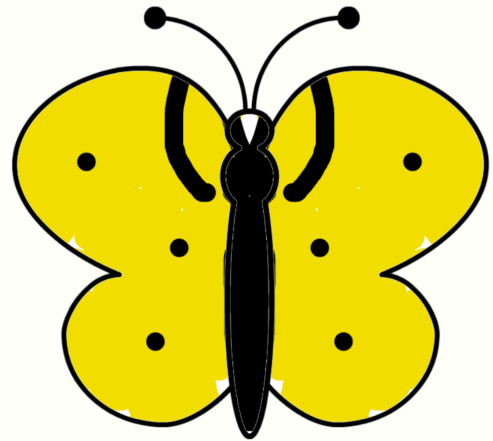
