Welcome to the new term! We hope you had a very restful Easter. This term our themes will be Space Explorers and Traction Man. Work has also been set on Education City and Purple Mash to practise specific strategies related to Maths, Reading and Science.

Spelling tests will be carried out on **Tuesdays** and all the lists for the year are available on Satchel and also on the school website.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom and books are changed regularly. We ask that you support your child's progress by reading regularly with them and completing the reading record when they have read to you. The book will only be changed when you have done so. Please encourage children to take care with the books as they cost a lot of money to replace.
