**Spelling tests** will be completed on a **Friday**. Spellings can be found on the school website. Also, children will be given a spelling sheet at the beginning of each half term which contains all of the spellings for the half term and for each week.

Children will be able to come into school in their **PE kits Monday and Tuesday for Moore Class and Tuesday and Wednesday for Perry Class**. Please ensure your child has the appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons and all items are labelled.
