Extra homework may also be provided to support learning in the classroom. Spelling tests will be carried out on <u>Fridays</u>. Please see the school website for the spelling list if you have misplaced it.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom and books are changed weekly. We ask that you support your child's progress by reading regularly with them and completing the reading record when they have read to you. The book will only be changed when you have done so.

As pupils are able to come into school earlier, this is an opportunity for your child to have tailored learning. If you would you like your child to access this, please ensure that your child is in school for **8:40am**.
