Ensure the children practice the times tables daily on TT Rockstars. **Spelling tests** will be completed weekly. The spelling list is on the school website.

**PE** is on **Tuesday (Outdoor) for Curie, Monday for Faraday, Thursday (indoor) for Curie and Wednesday for Faraday**. Please ensure your child has an appropriate kit for indoor and outdoor lessons and that all items are labelled. Earrings should not be worn on these days and no other jewelry should be worn to school.

Reading takes place daily in the classroom. Your child will have opportunities to choose various reading books throughout the term. These books should be brought home, and the reading record should be completed when your child reads. Please encourage your child to read daily at home and record it in their reading records.
