Dear Year 4 Parents/ Carers,

We hope you had a lovely Easter break. Thank you for continuing to stay safe through the covid period.

Our theme for this term is 'Cunning Creatures'. This half-term our English will be based around the book 'Varjak Paw', creating character descriptions and stories on creatures with super powers. Our Creative lessons will be based around the Galapagos Islands. We will be exploring why the Islands are special and looking at the different creatures on the Galapagos Islands.

In Maths, we will work on securing our knowledge of fractions and decimals.

Our topic in Science is Animals including humans. This will involve developing an understanding of the human body, digestive system and anatomy of animals.
