Daily reading is a key part of your child's home learning, and they have been given a reading journal to record when and what they are reading; it is expected that these are brought into school every day. Please check this regularly to ensure that your child is reading each day at home. It is always lovely to read any comments that you have about your child's reading too, so please do use it. Children will bring books home from school to read, but please ensure that your child is taking care of them. If your child loses a school reading book, or it is damaged irreparably there will be a fee of £5.

Einstein Class' PE days are Tuesday and Wednesday, whereas Walker Class' days are Wednesday and Friday. Your child must bring in the correct PE kit (black bottoms, a white top and trainers) on these days. Children can wear their PE kit to school on these days instead of their uniform as long as it is the approved kit (**plain white top, black bottoms, and black trainers**) .

Now your child is in Year 6, we do allow them to walk home alone. If you decide to let your child, go home, unaccompanied by an adult, you must inform a member of staff or send in a short note to give your permission.

We very much look forward to working with you to make your child's final year a great one. We have high expectations for the forthcoming SATs tests and anticipate good results from the children; especially if we work together.
