School Uniform



School uniform comprises of:

Grey skirt or trousers or pinafore dress, dark yellow polo shirt, burgundy sweatshirt

and/or a dark grey fleece

Grey trousers, dark yellow polo shirt, burgundy sweatshirt and/or a dark grey fleece

Safe, flat sensible shoes or trainers – black in colour

Small studs and a wrist watch if your child can tell the time

In the summer boys are allowed to wear grey school shorts and girls are allowed to wear red checked dresses.



Clothes labelling

Please label <u>all your child's belongings</u> clearly with their name, including their shoes, school bags, water bottles and PE kits.





PE kit

Children will have 2 PE sessions per week, on Monday and Wednesday; one indoor and one outdoor.

They are requested to bring their PE kits to school on a Monday and take them home to wash on a Friday. PE kits including the clothing need to be clearly labelled with your child's name.

They will need to get undressed and dressed independently for PE so please allow them time to practise at home.

Getting dressed



It is very useful if your child can dress and undress themselves when they join the school.

We do not require the majority of 4 year olds to be able to tie their own laces and do their buttons, but we do encourage them to try.

If you want your child to have laced shoes, then they need to be able to tie them themselves.

Velcro fastening shoes and slip on pumps can be less frustrating for both child and teacher in the early stages.

Belts are not appropriate.



School Dinners/ Packed Lunch

All children in Reception are entitled to a free school meal.

Alternatively, your child may bring a healthy packed lunch – sweets, chocolate bars and fizzy drinks are not allowed.



Your child will receive fresh fruit every day which is free of charge.

If you wish your child to have milk at school please speak to the school office.









Water bottles

- Please ensure your child has a water bottle so they can keep hydrated throughout the day.
- Please ensure you label it.



Lunch Times



Help is at hand to cut up food during lunchtime but we would expect all children to handle a knife and fork correctly, and sit sensibly at the table.



Going to the toilet

It can be very worrying if a child cannot manage to go to the toilet without assistance. There are often stiff fasteners, particularly on school trousers or tights which can be tricky. Do reassure your child that they can always go to the toilet when needed.

During class time whether they are inside or out they can access the toilet independently. All children should know how to flush the toilet after use and wash their hands independently.
